CIRCULAR

Sub: Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pre-Matric Scholarship for ST Students in class IXth & Xth for the year 2022-23.

Directorate of Tribal Welfare is implementing the Scheme namely:

Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pre Matric Scholarship for students belonging to Scheduled Tribe community studying in class IXth & Xth

Objective- The object of the scheme is to improve the educational status and arrest the tendency of drop- outs of Scheduled Tribes students by way of providing financial assistance to the families of such who are otherwise unable to send them to schools due to poverty.

Eligibility of the Scheme are as under:

1. Student should belong to Scheduled Tribe Community.
2. Her/ His Parents/ Guardians income should not exceed Rs. 2.00 lakh per annum.
3. She/ He should not be availing any other Centrally – funded Pre Matric Scholarship.
4. She/ he should be a regular, full time student studying in a Government School or in a school recognized by Govt. or a Central /State Board of secondary Education.
5. Scholarship for studying in any class will be available for only one year. If a student has to repeat a class, she/he is not eligible to get scholarship for that class for a second (or subsequent) year.

Applications under **Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pre Matric Scholarship for students belonging to Scheduled Tribe community studying in class IXth & Xth for the academic year 2022-23** are invited online on National Scholarship Portal <https://scholarships.gov.in> National Scholarship Portal is made open for students to apply with effect on 20th July, 2022 by NIC..

Submission of Applications- Fresh Students i.e. IX std. students shall first register themselves on the portal. Students studying in class Xth shall apply for renewal directly without registering again on the National Scholarship Portal. Nodal Officers for this Scheme from concerned schools shall guide the students accordingly.

Institute KYC submission and verification- Those institutions who are yet to register on the Portal shall contact this Directorate for assistance.

Application Verification (by School) – School shall verify applications promptly as per the guidelines of the scheme and submit the same to District Nodal Officer for verification.

Application verification by State/UT – The State / UT further verifies the received applications in the NSP.

Required documents are as under:For Fresh Students.

1. Attested copy of Income Certificate.
2. Attested copy of Caste Certificate issued by competent authority.
3. Attested Copy of Bank Pass Book Copy.
4. Attested copy of Marksheet.
5. Bonafide Certificate.

For Renewal Students.


1. Attested copy of Marksheet
2. Income Certificate
- 2 Bonafide Certificate.

All above documents shall be scanned uploaded on the National Scholarship Portal.

It may be noted that all the applications (Fresh/Renewal) under **Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pre Matric Scholarship for students belonging to Scheduled Tribe community studying in class IXth & Xth** shall be received online on or before 30/09/2022 on National Scholarship Portal as per the timeline of DBT Mission. (Copy enclosed)

The institute may bring the content of this circular to the notice of the student to avail the benefit of scheme. The institute shall convey the date of opening & Closing of the Portal to the students so that the students can apply before the last date.


