CIRCULAR

This Directorate launched the scheme “Eklavya Prashikshan Yojana” and from this academic year i.e. from 2023-24 Department is inviting applications from Xth std, XIth std and XIIth std students availing coaching classes from registered coaching institutes.

Objective of the scheme is to impart coaching to Scheduled Tribe Students studying in class Xth , XIth (science) and XIIth Arts, Science and Commerce.

Under the Scheme fees shall be reimbursed to the students enrolled in coaching institutes within the state of Goa recognised by Directorate of Education or are registered under Goa Coaching classes regulation Act 2001.

Under the Scheme students shall be reimbursed 75% of the fees paid (upto a ceiling of Rs. 10,000/- per annum per subject in rural areas and Rs.12,000/- per annum per subject in urban areas) to the coaching institutes upon submission of the fees receipt that is duly certified by the competent authority of the coaching institute.

The coaching fees of the students will be reimbursed for the classes as given below.

- 1) Class Xth Mathematics, Science & English.
- 2) Class XIth (Science stream) Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry & Biology.
- 3) Class XIIth (Science stream) Mathematics, Physics ,Chemistry & Biology.
- 4) Class XIIth (Commerce stream) Accountancy & Mathematics.
- 5) Class XIIth (Arts Stream) English & Economics.

There is no income criteria for the scheme. All eligible scheduled tribe students attending regular classes in the educational institution in the state of Goa and aided by the Government of Goa shall be eligible for the benefit under the scheme.

The student shall have to apply for the benefit under the scheme during the particular academic year there is no provision of deemed renewal. Student shall be eligible to seek benefit once in a particular standard.

In case students discontinue the coaching then student shall refund the reimbursed fees.

Student shall apply for the scheme in the prescribed format and shall attach following documents.




- 1) Birth Certificate of the student.
- 2) Aadhar Card of the student.
- 3) Bank mandate form along with account details of the student.
- 4) Identity Card issued by the educational institute to the student.
- 5) Fee receipt along with the fees structure of the classes offered by the coaching institute.
- 6) Certificate of registration issued to the coaching institute by the competent authorities.
- 7) Fee structure of the course, subjects offered by the coaching.

The above mentioned scheme is newly formulated scheme. All the heads of institutes are requested to make vide publicity of the above mentioned scheme among the Scheduled Tribes Students studying in your institutes.

Institutes /Students from North district can avail the application form of the scheme from the Directorate of Tribal Welfare, Patto-Panaji-Goa, students/institutes from the south district shall avail the application form from office of Dy.
